

SCHOOL POLICIES IN CASE OF INCLEMENT WEATHER

In the event of inclement weather (or other emergency), a school closing, delayed opening, or early dismissal could occur. An Option C parent alert message will be sent to you. You can also look for school closing, delayed opening, or early dismissal information on WFMZ-TV Channel 69. **If St. Theresa School is not specifically mentioned, the decision of the Saucon Valley School District will be followed.**

PRE-K 3

- If there is a 2-hour delay, no Pre-K 3 year old class is held.

PRE-K 4

- If there is a 2-hour delay, all Pre-K 4 year old classes (half day and full day) begin at 10:30 A.M.

SCHOOL (GRADES K-8)

- If there is a 2-hour delay, students should not arrive before 10 A.M.

EXTENDED CARE

- If there is a 2-hour delay, extended care is available in the morning from 7:00-10:00 A.M.
- **If school closes early due to weather or other emergency, after school extended care is not available.**

If severe weather causes the school to be closed, start late, or dismiss early, please make every effort to NOT call the school. It is important to keep the phone lines open to communicate with individual school districts to ensure we have the most accurate and current information. If weather is threatening, please send a note into school with your child explaining any change that will result to his or her dismissal procedures should school close early. Thank you for your cooperation and understanding.
