Parental Request for Administration of Medication
(This is a two-sided form)

This will confirm the fact that we have requested St. Theresa Preschool and in particular designated school employees, to administer the medication at such time or times as may be directed in writing by the family physician. We will furnish you with a supply of medication and agree, as an inducement to you to comply with our request, to relieve St. Theresa Preschool and Diocese of Allentown and designated employees from liability for injury due to use, misuse, or abuse of said medication or from any kind of injury which may arise from the administration of said medication by injection to our child, whether such damage, injury, use misuse, or abuse be caused by or result from the negligence of the Preschool, its servants, agents, or any other person or persons whatsoever.

I understand that if this release is for oral medication of a liquid medicine, the prescribed medicine will be in a plastic bottle if your child is to bring it to preschool. The bottle also is to contain only one day's supply. Furthermore, the name of the child, and the dosage must be clearly visible on the label on the bottle. If the medication is in the form of a pill, the container properly marked should only contain one day's supply. The other instructions above also apply.

All medication must be in the original container.
